

SJCC Game Day Protocols and Procedures

Football at Don Paul Stadium

1. All tickets will be pre sold. No tickets will be sold at the gate. We will be offering four tickets to each home and visiting player, each home and visiting cheerleader and each home band member. Our 15% capacity number would be 750 people. All tickets are \$5.00. There will be a no re-entry policy in effect. If a fan leaves the facility, they will not be allowed to re-enter.
2. Gates will open at 6:15 PM.
3. Only those fans holding a visitors ticket will be able to enter the East/Parking Lot Gate.
4. Only those fans holding a home ticket will be able to enter the South/Main Gate.
5. There will be hand sanitizer available for fan use at both gates.
6. There will be no concessions. Fans will be permitted to bring their own water bottle, but no coolers or back packs are allowed inside the stadium.
7. Masks must be worn when entering and exiting the stadium as well as in the stands.
8. Fans must practice social distancing while entering and exiting the stadium.. While in the stands families may sit in groups of four or less. Each family group must be 6 feet from any other family group as required by the social distancing requirement.
9. Signage showing the importance of wearing masks, washing or sanitizing hands and social distancing will be posted throughout the stadium. Frequent public announcements about these issues will be made during the game.
10. Visiting Teams will enter and exit their locker room through the West entrance. There will be hand sanitizer available for them in that area. Players and coaches must wear masks while entering the facility, entering the locker room, in the locker room, exiting the locker room and until they are on the field engaged in warm up activities. In the locker room coaches and players must practice social distancing. Coaches and players leaving the locker room will walk around the back of the stadium to the South end of the stadium where they may enter the playing field. Once the game starts all players and coaches on the sidelines must wear masks and practice social distancing. There will be hand sanitizer available to them on the sidelines.
11. Home Team will enter and exit their locker room through the East/Field entrance. There will be hand sanitizer available for them in that area. Players and coaches must wear masks while entering the facility, entering the locker room, in the locker room, exiting the locker room and until they are on the field engaged in warm up activities. In the locker room coaches and players must practice social distancing. Coaches and players leaving the locker room will walk through the hallway directly to the playing field. Once the game starts all players and coaches on the sidelines must wear masks and practice social distancing. There will be hand sanitizer available to them on the sidelines.

12. Each team will provide their own ball boys, who must wear masks all the time and practice social distancing while on the sidelines. They will need supplies provided by their own school, to sanitize their team's footballs when they toss out of play.
13. Each school should designate their own Compliance Officer to make sure their fans are practicing the safety protocols in place for the operation of high school sports. Visiting team should identify their compliance officer to the home school when arriving at the facility.
14. Once the game has concluded all fans are expected to leave the facilities immediately. There will be no gathering, no socializing or meeting with players. Players and coaches are expected to also leave the facility as soon as possible.

Volleyball at St. Joseph Central Catholic High School

1. All tickets will be pre sold. No tickets will be sold at the gate. For high school matches we will be offering two tickets to each home player and one ticket to each visiting player. Our 15% capacity limit is 120 people. All tickets will be \$5.00. For junior high matches we will be offering two tickets to both home and visiting players. All tickets will be \$3.00. There will be a no re-entry policy in effect. If a fan leaves the facility they will not be allowed to re-enter.
2. Gates will open at 4:45 PM for a jv and varsity match. Gates will open at 3:45 for a triple header. Gates will open at 4:15 for junior high games.
3. All fans will enter the high school using the right two front doors on Croghan Street. Tickets will be collected and temperature taken. If a temperature over 100 degrees is registered the fan will be asked to stand off to the side for five minutes and then the temperature will be taken again. If the temperature is below 100 degrees the fan will be allowed to enter. If the temperature is still over 100 degrees the fan will be asked to leave and go home. Once fans have entered the building they will go up the steps to the second floor. Staying to their right, the fans shall proceed down the main hallway and enter the gym by the stage. All fans are expected to sit on the West side in seats that are clearly marked. They may sit in family groups of two or less. Each family group must remain socially distant for any other family group. Anyone leaving the gym must exit the gym by the south doors (away from stage). To re-enter the gym fans must go down the main hallway and enter by the stage.
4. There will be hand sanitizer stations available through out the building.
5. There will be no concessions. Fans will be permitted to bring their own water bottle, but no coolers or back packs are allowed inside the school.
6. Masks must be worn as long as fans are inside our building.
7. Fans must practice social distancing while entering or exiting the building as well as in the hallways. While in the stands families may sit in groups of two or less. Each family group must be 6 feet from any other family group as required by the social distancing requirement. All fans are required to sit in designated seats.
8. Signage showing the importance of wearing masks, washing or sanitizing hands and social distancing will be posted throughout the building. Frequent public announcements about these issues will be made during the game.
9. Locker rooms will be available to both teams for rest room facilities only. Teams are expected to arrive dressed and ready to play. All Coaches and players must wear masks at all times inside the building unless actively participating in game activities. Once the game starts all players and coaches on the bench must wear masks and practice social distancing.
10. The home team will provide a person, who must wear masks all the time, to sanitize the game balls when the ball is tossed out of play at the end of a volley. There will be four game balls in use at all games.
11. Once the game has concluded all fans are expected to leave the facilities immediately. There will be no gathering, no socializing or waiting for players. Players and coaches are expected to also leave the facility as soon as possible.
